Heidelberg Catechism: Lord's Day 5 (page 10)

Q. According to God's righteous judgment we deserve punishment both in this world and forever after: how then can we escape this punishment and return to God's favor?

A. God requires that His justice be satisfied. Therefore the claims of His justice must be paid in full, either by ourselves or by another.

Q. Can we pay this debt ourselves?

A. Certainly not. Actually, we increase our guilt every day.

Q. Can another creature-any at all-pay this debt for us?

A. No. To begin with, God will not punish another creature for man's guilt. Besides, no mere creature can bear the weight of God's eternal anger against sin and release others from it.

Q. What kind of mediator and deliverer should we look for then?A. He must be truly human and truly righteous, yet more powerful than all creatures, that is, He must also be true God.

We are self-absorbed and seek pleasure above holiness. For the sake of our Savior, remember His sacrifice made for our sins, grant us forgiveness and in mercy apply His righteousness to us. We pray in His Name. Amen.

- <sup>8</sup> Thus says the Lord: "As the new wine is found in the cluster, and one says, 'Do not destroy it, For a blessing is in it,' So will I do for My servants' sake, that I may not destroy them all.
- <sup>9</sup> I will bring forth descendants from Jacob, and from Judah an heir of My mountains; My elect shall inherit it, and My servants shall dwell there.

- <sup>10</sup> Sharon shall be a fold of flocks, and the Valley of Achor a place for herds to lie down, for My people who have sought Me.
- <sup>11</sup> "But you are those who forsake the Lord, who forget My holy mountain, who prepare a table for Gad, and who furnish a drink offering for Meni.
- Therefore I will number you for the sword, and you shall all bow down to the slaughter; because, when I called, you did not answer; when I spoke, you did not hear, but did evil before My eyes, and chose that in which I do not delight."

- <sup>16</sup> So that he who blesses himself in the earth ahall bless himself in the God of truth; and he who swears in the earth shall swear by the God of truth; because the former troubles are forgotten, and because they are hidden from My eyes.
