Call to Worship: *Psalm 2:11* – Serve the LORD with fear, and rejoice with trembling.

Heidelberg Catechism: Lord's Day 8 (page 12)

Q. How are these articles divided?

A. Into three parts: God the Father and our creation; God the Son and our deliverance; God the Holy Spirit and our sanctification.

Q. Since there is but one God, why do you speak of three: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit?

A. Because that is how God has revealed Himself in His Word: these three distinct persons are one, true, eternal God.

Call to Confession: *2 Chronicles 30:9b* – "For the Lord your God is gracious and merciful, and will not turn His face from you if you return to Him."

Prayer of Confession: Father, we have failed to tremble before Your Word and have instead acted as if it is not worthy to be obeyed. We have failed to live according to the new nature we have received from Jesus. We have resisted the work of the Holy Spirit who would make us holy. We have been content to live in ignorance, not striving to learn more of You or to live in Your wisdom, but pursuing comfort in earthly things instead. For the sake of our Savior, remember His sacrifice made for our sins and grant us forgiveness. We pray in His Name. Amen.

Agnus Dei:

Women & Children: O Christ, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world, have mercy upon us.

- ³ "He who kills a bull is as if he slays a man; he who sacrifices a lamb, as if he breaks a dog's neck; he who offers a grain offering, as if he offers swine's blood; he who burns incense, as if he blesses an idol.
