Moments of Concern

Call to Worship: John 12:12-15 — The next day a great multitude that had come to the feast, when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem, took branches of palm trees and went out to meet Him, and cried out: "Hosanna! 'Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!' The King of Israel!" Then Jesus, when He had found a young donkey, sat on it; as it is written: "Fear not, daughter of Zion; behold, your King is coming, sitting on a donkey's colt."

Heidelberg Catechism: Lord's Day 14 (page 15)

- Q. What does it mean that He "was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary"?
 - A. That the eternal Son of God, who is and remains true and eternal God, took to Himself, through the working of the Holy Spirit, from the flesh and blood of the virgin Mary, a truly human nature so that He might become David's true descendant, in all things like us His brothers except for sin.
- Q. How does the holy conception and birth of Christ benefit you?
 - A. He is our mediator, and with His innocence and perfect holiness He removes from God's sight my sin-mine since I was conceived.
