Call to Worship: *Psalm 44:20-22, 26* – If we had forgotten the name of our God, or stretched out our hands to a foreign god, would not God search this out? For He knows the secrets of the heart. Yet for Your sake we are killed all day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter... Arise for our help, and redeem us for Your mercies' sake. **Heidelberg Catechism:** Lord's Day 21 (page 19)

- Q. What do you believe concerning "the holy catholic church"?
