Heidelberg Catechism: Lord's Day 43 (pages 32-33)

- Q. What is God's will for us in the ninth commandment?
  - A. God's will is that I never give false testimony against anyone, twist no one's words, not gossip or slander, nor join in condemning anyone without a hearing or without a just cause. Rather, in court and everywhere else, I should avoid lying and deceit of every kind; these are devices the devil himself uses, and they would call down on me God's intense anger. I should love the truth, speak it candidly, and openly acknowledge it. And I should do what I can to guard and advance my neighbor's good name.

Let Your tender mercies come speedily to meet us, for we have been brought very low. Help us, O God of our salvation, for the glory of Your name; and deliver us, and provide atonement for our sins, for Your name's sake!

**Prayer of Confession:** Father in heaven, forgive us for we have been deceitful. We have twisted others' words. uncomfortable situations. Cleanse us from practices of which Satan approves, and give us wisdom and boldness to promote truth. Train our hearts to love truth. We pray in the Name of Jesus. Amen.
